- Rates are subject to change at any time and may be different during special events.
- Non-heated cabins, Cottages, and Vintage Rental Trailers open in March and close in November, weather permitting.

- Holiday Trav-L-Park will not assume responsibility for lost or stolen articles, please lock your valuables and your vehicles.

RULES

FOR EVERYONE'S SAFETY AND PLEASURE, WE ASK FOR YOUR ASSISTANCE IN OBSERVING OUR POLICIES AND RULES DURING YOUR VISIT.

Reservations and Registration

- Campsite rates include 2 adults and up to 4 children under the age of 18. Rustic Cabin rates include 2 adults and 2 children. Maximum occupancy is 6 people per campsite and 4 people per cabin. Studio Cabins, Rental Trailers, Cottages and Lodge occupancies vary and are specific to each unit.
- Do not change sites until you have made the change with the registration office. Do not set up any site without registering and checking in. Park your vehicle on your campsite only and do not block the neighboring site which may arrive late night.
- Reservations are guaranteed for a site type, not specific sites, although we will do our best to honor your request. Request for a specific site may not be honored for reservations less than 5 nights. If you wish to extend your stay, there is no guarantee that it can be done on the same site.
- The maximum stay is 14 days for rental units (Cabins, Trailers, Cottages, etc.), 21 days for a tent or water and electric sites, and 90 days for sites types with sewer connections. If you would like to stay longer, you must contact the office manager.
- A deposit of \$300 (or full amount if less) is required on all reservations at the time they are made. Also, on rental units' full payment is to be made at least 2 weeks in advance of arrival. Reservations with no deposit are subject to cancel without notification.
- Campsite reservations canceled or changed with at least 7 days' notice will incur a \$20 charge per week canceled or changed. Campsite reservations cancelled or changed with-in 7 days of arrival will forfeit a one-night deposit per week cancelled or changed.
- Rental Unit reservations canceled or changed within 2 weeks of arrival will forfeit the full payment. All refunds will be made in the same form as the payments were received.
- Sites and cabins will not be rented to people under 21 years of age or to groups with unrelated people under 21 years of age.
- Have your ID and credit card with you and available for registration purposes.

Resort Polices- Follow the golden rule- "Do unto others what you would have them do unto your grandmother!"

- Check-out time is 11am. Check-in time is 1pm for Campsites. Check-in time for rental units is 3pm. If you have a rental unit, you will be asked for a credit card to be presented and kept on file for damage deposit. If you depart late or cause damage to the unit, you may be subject to the additional charges. Special arrangements must be made if you wish to arrive or depart from a rental unit outside of office hours.
- Quiet hours are 11pm to 7am. At all times you must be respectful of those around you and understand that your music is for your personal listening and should not disturb those around you. Be courteous and keep the volume down.
- If you have a boat or cargo/utility trailer, we ask that you speak with the office and make arrangements to park it in an overflow parking spot, not at the campsite.
- All vehicles must display a vehicle pass at all times. Rates include one vehicle per site; additional vehicles are \$5 per night. A maximum of 2 cars may be parked on a site or 1 car at a cabin. All other vehicles can be left in our overflow parking lot by the guard house (extra vehicle fee will apply).
- ATVs, motorized scooters, mini bikes, and go carts are prohibited. Gas powered golf carts and off-road vehicles are prohibited. All permitted motorized vehicles must be operated by a license and insured driver.
- Bicycles, scooters, skateboards, and similar are not permitted in the pool areas or on the miniature golf course.
- Respect other peoples' space, privacy, and property. Do not cut through other guests' campsites. Do not take property from another campsite. Do not vandalize or damage property, including trees and shrubs.
- Fireworks, explosives, and display or use of firearms are prohibited.
- Speed limit: 10mph (15km/h) unless otherwise posted.
- Comfort stations are closed several times daily for cleaning. Give our cleaning crews a break and respect these closures by using a different facility.
- Parents are responsible for the actions and safety of their children. All campers under the age of 18 must return their campsites by 11pm. Parents are asked to accompany children in the comfort stations.

Campsite Rules

- If you need to leave your campsite earlier than anticipated and you notify the office by 11am at least one day before early departure, fees for unused days will be returned less a \$20.00 early departure fee. Refunds and vouchers are not given for rental units.
- Do not wash your vehicle or RV at your campsite. Arrangements can be made in the office for you to access our maintenance area to wash with water.
- Campers are asked to maintain a clean campsite and when departing to leave it in good order for the next guest. Report any out-of-order equipment to an employee or the office.
- Alcoholic beverages may be consumed on your campsite. Consume responsibly.
- Discharge onto the surface of the ground of waste water such as dishwater or shower waste is prohibited by law. Such liquid must be captured and disposed through our sewer system, such as one of our dump stations. Campers may be asked to depart the camp ground depending on severity.
- Campfires are permitted to be made on the ground in a safe location that cannot cause damage to property.
- Campsites rates include 1 vehicle per site. A second vehicle is permitted for a fee and must be registered with the office. Any additional vehicles need to be registered and parked in our overflow parking areas.
- Do not leave valuables outdoors or unattended. We cannot monitor your property and you are responsible for keeping it secured. **LOCK YOUR DOORS!**

Pet Policies- Remember to Scoop the Poop and Trash it

- Pets are permitted at campsites provided they are leashed, attended to at all times while outdoors and cleaned up after. If your pet is a nuisance to other campers, you will be asked to resolve the problem.
- Breed restrictions include **Pit Bull** type breeds and mixes.
- Pets are permitted in our rustic air-conditioned cabins for a fee and a maximum number of pets allowed is 3.
- Pets are not permitted in our pool areas, bathhouses, store or café.
- Pets are not permitted in our other rental units such as; (trailers, cottages, lodges, non-air-conditioned cabins, etc.).
- Pets must be on a leash and under control when outdoors. They may not be left unattended outdoors no matter how they may be restrained – if the pet is outdoors someone must be outdoors with even if it is kenneled. The only exception for pets off leash is when using our Dog Park in the Beachtree Forest area.
- Pets must be cleaned up after and their waste disposed of in trash cans.

Pool Rules

- Pools are for registered guests only. In season, they begin to open at 9am and close by 10pm. Children under 14 years of age must be supervised by an adult. No ball throwing in the pool area. For safety, no floats please. Personal music players are restricted to low volume or headphones.
- Swim at your own risk. Parents are responsible for the safety and actions of their children. No children under the of 14 are permitted in the pool without adult supervision.
- Do not bring any glass into the pool areas.
- No diving, running, jumping off of any structure in or around the pool areas.

Visitor Policies

- Visitors and overnight guests must check in with the guard at the gate or the office before entering the campground and pay applicable fees.
- Visitors staying less than 4 hours are charged \$2 per person; those staying more than 4 hours are asked to pay \$10 per adult, \$3 per child. These rates are subject to change for events and holiday times.
- Visitors are required to leave the campground prior to 8pm. Visitors wishing to stay after 8pm must register in the office as overnight guests, as long as the site does not exceed the maximum allowable campers, as stated previously under the "Registration and Rules" section.

Golf Cart Rules- Only drivers 21 and older permitted to drive our rentals or personal carts

- As with cars, speed limit of golf carts is 10mph.
- Golf carts need to respect the rules of the road, remaining on their side of the road, respecting stop signs and pedestrians.
- All personal golf carts **must** be electric. **NO GAS-POWERED GOLF CARTS ALLOWED.**
- Golf cart drivers must be 21 years of age and have a valid driver's license.
- As with cars, driving a golf cart while intoxicated is illegal.

Trash Disposal

- Trash is picked up several times throughout the day from campsites we will remove only trash bags and items left beside the site post. Please do not place trash outside after 5pm. You may place trash in the dumpster located beside Comfort Station #2 if you wish to dispose of trash after 5pm.
- Do not dispose of anything other than RV and Campsite garbage. We will not accept larger items such as furniture, mattresses, appliances etc.
